BOARDING ARRANGEMENTS

FULL BOARD: \$600.00

HALF BOARD: \$450.00

Plus the price of at least one of the monthly lesson or training packages.

“Full Board” includes a large box stall; feeding 2 or 3 times daily; mucking out; replacing bedding when needed; watering; once-daily semi-private turnout in a field or paddock with private turnout by arrangement; and blanketing (waterproof). We also schedule and hold your horse for the farrier and the vet as needed.

“Half Board” includes all of the care given with full board. The horse will be used several times per week in our lesson program.

If necessary, lesson packages may be converted to training sessions without the owner's presence. Lessons or training must be used monthly and cannot be retained to the next month. If your horse is not able to be ridden you may ride one of the stable's mounts at no extra charge.

Boarders are entitled to use all the facilities, including:

*The Indoor Arena
*The Stadium Jumps

*The Outdoor Arena
*The Cross Country Fences and Trails

Our farrier will shoe horses on every Wednesday. When you pay your board bill, we ask that you also leave a check made out to the farrier. We will schedule and assist the farrier with your horse.

All horses will be dewormed by management once every six weeks at no charge.

Annual spring/fall inoculations required and are the responsibility of the horse owners. We will schedule and hold your horse for this procedure.

The following are items you will need to provide for your horse(s):

*Water Buckets *Hay Net (optional) *Saddlery
*Feed Tub *Halter and Lead Rope *Current Negative Coggins Test

Minor medical treatments may be provided by the school:

*Full Boarders: upon payment of a fee established by special arrangement.
*Half Boarders: gratis, by arrangement.

Grooming, mane pulling, braiding, etc., is offered at additional charges.

The Chief riding instructor, Anne Cowles, was trained in England and holds the British Horse Society Horsemasters/Prelim. Instructor Certificate. A former preliminary level event rider she also competed successfully at Fourth Level Dressage competition. Various clinics are held during the year by other visiting professional instructors.
