We ask our students to be consistent in their riding schedules and dedicated to the sport to ensure that both horses and riders are happy, safe and successful.

The chief riding instructor trained in England and holds the British Horse Society Horsemasters/Prelim. Instructor Certificate. A former successful preliminary level event competitor, she currently competes at Fourth Level Dressage. The assistant instructor is an HA graduate of the United States Pony Clubs. She has trained and competed in the United Kingdom and Australia in dressage and eventing.

Introductory Lessons and Single Rides

The introductory lesson is a half-hour private lesson and the price is **\$40.00**. For one-time visiting riders the price is **\$60.00**. The ride could be a 30-minute private lesson or an hour group lesson.

Lesson Procedures

Riders are expected to tack and untack their horses—with assistance if necessary. To ensure that you are not rushing around the horses, please **arrive a ½ hour earlier** than the scheduled ride time for tacking. Plan on remaining a ½ hour after the riding lesson is finished for untacking.

Riding Attire: if you do not have riding clothes, please wear loose or stretch pants and hard shoes with a flat heel. Helmets will be provided at no charge. No tennis shoes permitted while riding. The maximum weight allowed is 190 lbs. for all riders.

Payment and Scheduling

Riders are expected to write their names in the schedule book located at the indoor arena. Students must give **24 hours notice of cancellations** and are responsible for rescheduling that lesson before the end of the month. For cancellations within 24 hours, or no-shows, the rider will be charged for the lesson. The rider is responsible for taking the lessons in each monthly package before the end of the month; **packages expire on the last day of each month**.
